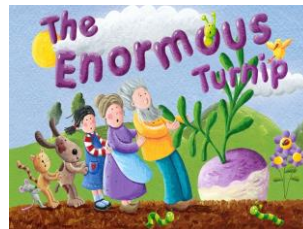
The children have been very busy making models using lots of different construction toys. We have put them on display. So we know who they belong to the children have been writing name labels. We are all so impressed.
