By the end of Reception, pupils will know and be able to:

- See themselves as a valuable individual.
- Build constructive and respectful relationships.
- Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.

## **Building Relationships (ELG)**

- Form positive attachments to adults and friendships with peers.
- Show sensitivity to their own and to others' needs.
- Understand that some places are special to members of their community.
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

## People Culture and Communities (ELG)

• Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class.

By the end of year 1 pupils will know and be able to:

-Reflect on what it means to be an individual. All About Me

-Reflect on how special occasions show what is important to people. Special Occasions

-Reflect on how we should look after each other and other living creatures. Our World

-Understand how special things show what is important to people. Special Things

By the end of year 2 pupils will know and be able to:

-Understand that some stories can carry a special meaning or moral. Special Stories

-Recognise what special places can tell us about the beliefs, feelings, practices and values of people who go there. *Important Places* 

-Understand the difference it makes to belong to a group or community. Belonging

-Understand that certain people have affected the lives of others. *Important People* 

By the end of year 3 pupils will know and be able to:

-Understand about what religions teach about how life might be lived. Ethics and Moral Issues

-Understand how festivals express important religious beliefs. Festivals

-Understand what religions teach about God. Symbolism

-Understand how places of worship help believers feel closer to God. Places of Worship

-Understand what rites of passage say about religious beliefs and attitudes. Rites of Passage

-Understand the key beliefs of the Jewish faith. *Community* 

By the end of year 4 pupils will know and be able to: -Understand how key religious people influence faiths today. *Founders and Prophets* -Understand what religions and science say about creation. *Natural World* -Know some key teachings from sacred texts and how they are interpreted. *Sacred Texts* -Understand some of the different beliefs of denominations. *Diversity in Religions* -Understand how worship expresses different beliefs. *Worship* 

By the end of year 5 pupils will know and be able to:

-Consider whether key religious people set a good example. Founders and Prophets

-Understand how holy books help believers in their daily lives. *Sacred Texts* 

-Understand what festivals mean to individuals and communities. *Festivals* 

-Understand how rites of passage affect individuals and communities. *Rites of Passage* 

-Understand the role places of worship in faith communities. *Places of Worship* 

-What beliefs do religions have in common and which do they not? *Religion in the Community* 

By the end of year 6 pupils will know and be able to:

- -Understand how worship helps believers in their daily lives. Worship
- -Understand how language and symbols express deep ideas, beliefs and feelings. Symbolism
- -Understand the purpose and effect of pilgrimage. *Pilgrimage*
- -Discuss opinions on the purpose of life. Natural World
- -Discuss how different denominations can exist together. Diversity in Religions
- -Consider the relevance of religious teachings in the modern world. Ethics and Moral Issues
