Dear Parents and Carers

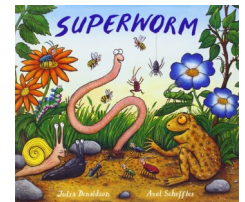
The highlight of our week was P.E. on the field again and asking the children to complete a range of challenges. We went to the field with Nursery and were impressed by how the Reception children showed them what to do and looked after them. Thank you Reception!



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In Mathematics this week we have been learning all about data handling. We have enjoyed completing quizzes to find out the children's favourites before focussing on creating simple graphs and recording using a tally. The children have all tried hard to record this information themselves and have impressed us by remembering how the five bar tally is formed.

We have spent our Literacy time looking at Superworm this week. We have continued to think about story structure but we have also been thinking carefully about the rhyming words in the story. The children have had a go at writing about Superworm and once again, they have used their phonics well in order to sound out what they want to write. Lots of the children are now independently writing sentences which we can read and are trying hard to use capital letters and full stops. Fantastic!
