Old warm jumper and joggers may be worn in addition for outdoor games in cold weather

- Hair should be neat and smart at all times. Long hair must be tied back. Hairbands and hairclips should be neutral colours or navy blue and there should be no other hair accessories, for example bows. Only larger items such as scrunchies and plain Alice bands are acceptable in a dark blue colour.
- The school does not allow dyed hair or fashion hairstyles such as Mohicans or tramlines or where the hair is obviously of differing lengths.
- Children should not wear make-up including lipstick.
- Only small silver or gold studs maybe worn. No hoops or fashion earrings. Children wearing anything but silver or gold studs will be asked to remove them. Earrings must be taped over for P.E. lessons.

Lastly, I would like to add that the school office will also have a supply of second-hand uniform. The school office will be able to assist you if you wish to order second-hand uniform.
