

FONTHILL GIFFORD PARISH COUNCIL
MINUTES of the Meeting held on Monday 2 March 2026

There were present Cllr James Hill, Chairman, Cllr Paul Gorford, Treasurer, Cllrs Cheryl Bell and Mary Scott-Gall

Apologies were received from Cllrs James Evans, Caroline Marking and Helen Thorp
Cllr Gerry Murray was also in attendance.

1. There were no Declarations.
2. The Minutes of the previous Meeting were read and signed.
3. Matters arising: The Chair will discuss with Cllr James Evans exactly where the new speeding signs should be erected.
4. Financial Statement: The Treasurer reported that the balance on the Current Account stands at £1446, and on the Deposit Account at £2101, making a total of £3547.
5. Any other business: A further small rock fall from the stone wall on the North side of Stop Street was discussed. The Estate has reported that the relevant stone workers are currently completing some work at the Old Abbey, after which they will inspect then undertake the necessary repair work to reinstate the wall.
6. Councillor Murray reported that the County budget has now been approved for the year. He emphasised that he is continuing to press for repair of the minor roads throughout our part of the county. The Chair reported that three potholes in Stop Street have been filled in, but he stressed that the repairs are not effected to a high standard, making it highly likely that further repairs will be needed before too long.

There being no further business, the Meeting was declared closed.
