
CURRENT AND UPCOMING EVENTS



Patriots 4 Pendleton started a new program a few years ago and it quickly became a favorite – of ours, of our families and of so many donors. That program is the *BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLY GIVEAWAY*. As there are seven units we'd like to donate school supplies to, this program is starting now and will last through September. With all the summer vacations, starting early and running three months will give everyone who wants to participate plenty of time to do so. We have one unit who will be having their family summer event in July and would like to give their supplies out at that event. We will be collecting school supplies (items such as pens, pencils, paper, notebooks, crayons, markers, rulers, post-it-notes, etc) for kids from K to 12th grade and invite all of our Patriots to participate. You can either donate supplies needed, including backpacks, and we'll put them together or you can donate backpacks that include the supplies needed for a successful school year. PTSD stands for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder and is a condition that many veterans and non-veterans alike suffer. PTSD can occur when someone experiences or witnesses a traumatic event. This condition wasn't always understood properly by the medical or military community, and Department of Defense press releases often point to earlier attempts to identify PTSD symptoms in the wake of service in World War 2, Vietnam, and other conflicts. PTSD Awareness Day is observed every year on June 27th.

In 2010, Senator Kent Conrad pushed to get official recognition of PTSD via a "day of awareness" in tribute to a North Dakota National Guard member who took his life following two tours in Iraq,

Staff Sergeant Joe Biel died in 2007 after suffering from PTSD; Biel committed suicide after his return from duty to his home state. SSgt Biel's birthday, June 27, was selected as the official PTSD Awareness Day, which is now observed every year. Please remember those suffering from this condition in your prayers, we must bring an end to the suicides.

In 2014, the Senate designated the full month of June for National PTSD Awareness.
