

National K9 Veterans Day, March 13, is a day set aside to honor commemorate the service and sacrifices of American military and working dogs throughout history.

It was on March 13, 1942, that the Army began

training for its new War Dog Program, also known as

the "K-9 Corps," according to American Humane, marking the first time that dogs were officially a part

of the U.S. Armed Forces.

The rest, as they say, is history. Officially a part of

the service or not, the dogs of war span centuries and

include such heroes as Sgt. Stubby, the original war

dog; Chips, the most decorated dog in World War

II; Lex, who retired with his fallen owners family; and Cairo, the Navy SEAL working dog on the Osama bin Laden raid.
