Our male Marine had been in the Corps for 4 years and was only 22. He was just promoted to the rank of Sergeant on February 1.

P4P was honored to donate a wreath to each Marine to be displayed at their service.



National K9 Veterans Day, March 13, is a day set aside to honor the service and sacrifices of American military and working dogs throughout history. The lives of many have been saved thanks to the service of our four-legged warriors It was on March 13, 1942, that the Army began training for its new War Dog program, also known as the "K-9 Corps", marking the first time that dogs were officially a part of the United States Armed Forces. Military working dogs have served in every conflict since WWII to help support their human counterparts – from sentry operations to tactical patrols, mine detection, messengers and scout dogs.

On March 29th, we commemorate the 8th Anniversary of National Vietnam War Veterans Day, as Americans unite to thank and honor Vietnam veterans for their service and sacrifice. The Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act of 2017 was signed by 45th U.S. President Trump, designating every March 29 as National Vietnam War Veterans Day. Thank you to those who served in Vietnam. We never miss a chance to welcome them home, something they didn't experience when they came home.
