


Every **April**, all month long, we celebrate the courage, perseverance and tenacity demonstrated by our military-connected children, youth and teens and what they mean to our community.

This special celebration of military children was **established in 1986 by Defense Secretary Caspar Weinberger**. Weinberger was a WWII Veteran and father of two who realized the unique sacrifices and challenges military children faced as a result of their parent or parents' military service.

There are more than 1.6 million military children who face many challenges and unique experiences as a result of their parents' service. While military members serve around the world, we often forget the challenges faced by their children. Military families move on average every two to three years, impacting military children through changing schools and support networks.

Purple is the official color of the military child. It's a combination of all the colors of the U.S. Armed Force: Air Force, Navy, and Coast Guard blues, Army green, and Marine Corps red. Programs and activities that are similar across all branches of service are called "purple." Patriots 4 Pendleton is proud to support military children year-round and are always in awe at how polite and kind these children are and they truly are brave, strong and resilient.





The 15th MEU has deployed and we are humbly asking that you remember them and their families in your prayers. Prayers for strength, wisdom and safety for the Marines and Sailors and prayers for freedom from anxiety for their families. Deployment is the most difficult thing a military family will go through. 
