


# HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION COMMUNITY UPDATE

## Stay on top of your HOA account and contact information!

Did you know you can check your HOA account using the Vantica system on the Heritage website? Go to <a href="heritage-property.com">heritage-property.com</a> and select the bars in the corner to access the owner login page. Create an account if you don't have one. You can:

- · Find our HOA covenant and by-laws
- Make sure your contact and email information is up to date
- See if your account is in good standing. This is a great place to check if you have had a late payment or violation fine levied against your account. Fines are compounding. Please don't let an oops grow to something out of control.

### **VOTE**

Georgia began sending ballots to people who are registered to vote by mail on September 19 for the upcoming election. Have you received yours? To check the status of your ballot, <u>click here</u>.

Expect longer wait times at the polls on November 3, 2020

Important tips for completing your mail-in ballot:

- Complete your ballot and then sign your name using the same signature on your driver's license and/or voter registration.
- Sign the outer envelope and print your name.
- Return your ballot as soon as possible.

Mail your ballot by October 27 or drop it off inperson by November 3 at 7pm. Search for a secure ballot drop box location in your county by <u>clicking here</u>.



#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Do I need to pay to mail in my ballot?

Yes, you must include 2 stamps on your mail-in ballot. Otherwise, you can drop it off.

### How do I know my ballot is being sent or has been received?

You can track the status of your voter registration and mail-in ballot on My Voter Page. You can also sign up for notifications about your ballot's status here.

#### Do I have to mail my ballot?


No, you can return your ballot to a designated ballot drop box location or to your county registrar's office. You may not drop off your mail-in ballot at an election day polling location. Search for your county registrar here OR search for a secure ballot drop box location in your county here.

#### Can I update my signature?

You can submit a new voter registration form <u>online</u> or by <u>mail</u> (postage included). By re-submitting online, the signature on your State ID will become the signature on record.


