Principal's Update

- Just got enrollment numbers for next year – we have 78 confirmed for kindergarten, 4th grade is full, other grades are close to full.
 - Kindergarten registration is May 6, we'll also have Kindergarten camp this summer
 - Next year's budget is looking pretty much identical to last year. There will be one reduction next year for support staff, but no impact to teaching staff.
 - Next year special ed staff will increase to 2 teachers and 2 paraprofessionals.
 - Recent school expenditures include new book club books and 10 LCD projectors for classrooms. We'll have a healthy budget to run the building next year (~\$54,000).
