<p>LEAGUE PLAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No handshakes before or after the games.• Scoreboards will be available to use• Spares who are not club members must sign the waiver forms and supply contact information <p>CLEANLINESS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masks are required while in the building except to play the game of curling or if actively eating or drinking in the facility <p>WAIVERS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All curlers must sign a Curl Canada waiver and provide email address for contact tracing purposes <p>BAR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Proper social distancing and spacing is in effect. Please do not move tables and chairs around the bar area.	<p>REFUND POLICY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A pro-rated refund policy or credit to next season's fees will apply if curling is cancelled and less than 75% of the draws were played.• Volunteer bonds will be returned if less than 75% of the draws were played. <p>LOCKER ROOMS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lockers will be available for use this season.
