Registration/Tuition

- \$30 Annual Registration Fee per student *For returning students only: cost increases to \$50 after Early Bird Deadline.
- Additional \$40 Annual Registration Fee for Competition Team Students
- Registration Fees are Non-refundable
- Additional fees may occur throughout the year for head pieces, props, etc.

- Solos/Duos/Trios are required to also take a class in the same style.
- Family Discount: \$3/each additional family member registered.

- Annual Discount: 10% off annual tuition
- Solos/Duos/Trios excluded from discounts.
