Attire

All students must have proper dance attire to attend class. Leotards, canis, or tanks with dance pants, capri leggings or dance spandex should be worn to class. Desired color schemes may be chosen by the student. Students will be required to wear tights to all dance classes.

Proper dance shoes will be required for all students and should be purchased through the studio. Please do not go out and purchase your own shoes, as these will not be accepted. (i.e. Walmart, Payless Shoes, Target)

All hour ballet classes will require a Black leotard, Pink tights and Black booty shorts that can be ordered for you through the studio.

- Lyrical.....Please check with instructor
- Hour Ballet.....Pink leather Split-Sole
- Ballet.....White leather Split-Sole (no ties)
- Jazz.....Black jazz booties
- Tap.....Black patent leather buckle tap (no ties)
- Higher levels.....Black tie Oxford tap
- Clogging.....White and/or black clogging shoe (Please check with instructor)
- Irish.....black gillie shoe or hard-sole at higher level

Hair

Hair should be neatly worn away from face and must be pulled up or tied back. Absolutely no gum chewing allowed in class, as it could be very dangerous to the student. Please make sure all students have their own hair ties in their dance bag.

Etiquette

Students are expected to be polite and courteous to their instructors as well as each other. Rude behavior will not be tolerated. ALL visitors must remain in our waiting room during class time. There are two-way mirrors for you to view the class. Please arrive at the studio 10 minutes early to prepare yourself for class. Tardiness for class means interruption to your fellow classmates.

Payment

There will be a \$25.00 yearly registration fee for each student. This non-refundable fee includes placement in class and a copy of your recital dance music. There will be a \$35 yearly Competition fee for all Competition Team Members. This fee is non-refundable and covers the administrative and postage fees for all competitions as well as some building material costs for larger props. This does not include head pieces or additional individual props that may be required. The yearly tuition fee may be paid all at once or divided into 9 monthly, interest free, installment payments as follows: Each 45 minute class is charged individually. They are not added together to determine monthly tuition.

We do not offer the ability to take just a 1/2 hour class. Solos, Duos and Trios are required to take a class in the same subject signed up for. Paying for the year in full carries a 10% discount and is due by Oct. 15th.

A 5% discount will be given to anyone paying their full tuition fee in 3 payments. These payments are due Oct. 1st, Dec. 1st, and March 1st. Paying in full in advance will earn a 10% discount. Solo, Duo, Trio and Unlimited classes are excluded from this discount. Each additional family member registering will receive tuition at \$3.00 off for the lesser member. Discounts can NOT be combined.

Please Note: Payments are due the first of every month. If your payment is not received by the 15th of the month, a \$25 late charge per student will be added to your account (regardless of the date your class falls on). Please make sure to include this charge in your late payment. Your child will also be asked to watch class and not participate. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

*Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 charge over and above ALL bank charges.

Calendar

Carol Lawrence School of Dance closely follows the Balston Spa Central School District calendar for holidays, vacations and snow days. If there is no school, there is no dance (unless otherwise specified - please be sure to check the bulletin board). Please view the School Closing Network on your TV for early release due to weather in order to see if the studio will open or closed. Everyone must pay for classes missed regardless of the reason, so please encourage your child to attend all classes. There will be no make-up classes unless designated by the instructor. This includes solo, duo and trio classes as well.

Performances & Costumes

Price will be \$75 per costume (per class) for child sizes up to a large child and \$85 per costume (per class) for extra large child through large adult. XL adult, please add \$15 per costume. XXL adult please add \$20 per costume. These prices do not include head pieces or accessories that your child may need. Our costumes are not custom-made and sizes are generic. We are sorry, but any alterations needed will be at the expense of the customer.

A 50% deposit on all costumes is due on or before October 15th. The remaining balance will be due on or before November 15th. After November 15th, if balance is not paid in full, unfortunately, we will not be able to place an order for costumes. If you wish for your child not to participate in our annual recital please notify us by October 15th. After this date you will be responsible for all monies due on your child's costumes. These monies are non-refundable.

A required Performance Package for ALL students (NO EXCEPTIONS) will be due by March 15th. This will include a Recital T-shirt needed for our closing number and one pair of tights. This package will run approximately \$30. If additional tights are needed for your child an order form will be sent home right after winter break.

Please Note: We do offer several fundraising options throughout the dance year to help defray your costume and performance package costs.

We hope all of our students have a wonderful, fun learning experience at our studio and continue to grow through the art of dance. At this time a special thank you goes out to all of our parents who enrolled their children with us this year
