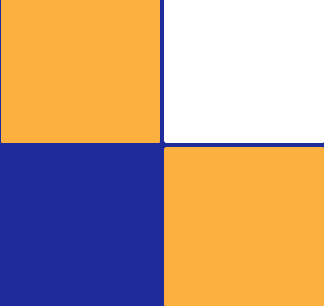
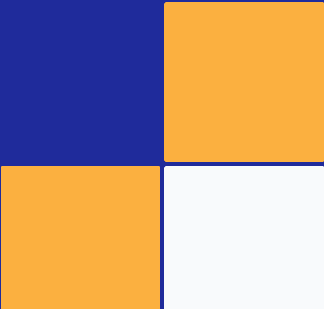

Thrift Center



Pronto of Long Island's Thrift Center offers gently used items to people in need. The thrift store is a way for people to get key items they may need, such as clothing, bedding, or household items. In addition, those in great need may get clothing for free through a voucher.

Pantry



Our warehouse is key to helping us feed our neighbors. We keep our shelves stocked, so that the people we help can keep theirs as well. We stock our shelves with fruit, vegetables, bread, and other items to ensure they can live healthy and whole lives. A significant amount of the food is rescued, including from partners like Costco, BIMBO, and La Ricura.

Resource fairs



Pronto of Long Island organizes multi-vendor service events that bring a range of providers together in one location to deliver direct support to the community. Each event features organizations offering services such as food distribution, health resources, legal assistance, and social support. Residents can access multiple forms of assistance in a single visit without navigating separate systems. The approach concentrates resources, increases efficiency, and expands reach to underserved populations. These vendor-based events create a coordinated, high-impact model for delivering essential services.
