The Zonta Club of Greater Sandusky will be providing a \$1000 scholarship for a female senior in your high school graduating class. For 2020 we will accept applications from Edison, Margareta, Perkins and Vermilion. In odd calendar years, we will accept applications from Bellevue High School, Huron High School, Sandusky Central Catholic High School, and Sandusky High School. Zonta International is a worldwide service organization that works to empower women through service and advocacy. Every year we provide scholarships to the area schools on this alternating basis.

Since Zonta is a women's service organization, and to be consistent with our goals, this scholarship will go to a graduating senior girl who will be attending a college or university in the fall of 2020 and will be majoring in a science, technology, engineering or mathematics field and who meets high academic standards. To provide some examples, our past recipients have been young women who majored in pharmacy, chemistry, engineering, forensic science, secondary mathematics education, and various fields of medicine.

The Zonta Club of Greater Sandusky will be choosing the winner of the scholarship from your school. Thus, multiple graduating seniors that qualify should apply. The award will be presented at our May 2020 Club Installation banquet. Date and time to be provided in the letter announcing the winner.
