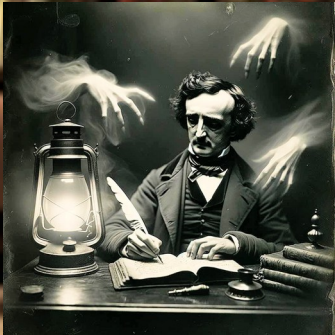

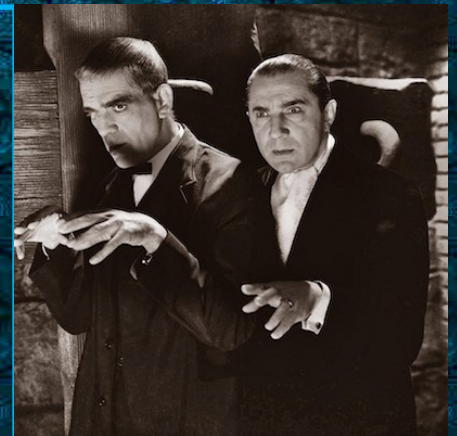
Backstage - An Anthology of Vaudeville Stories

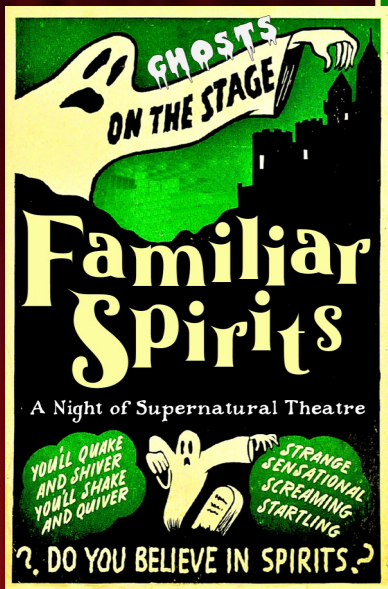

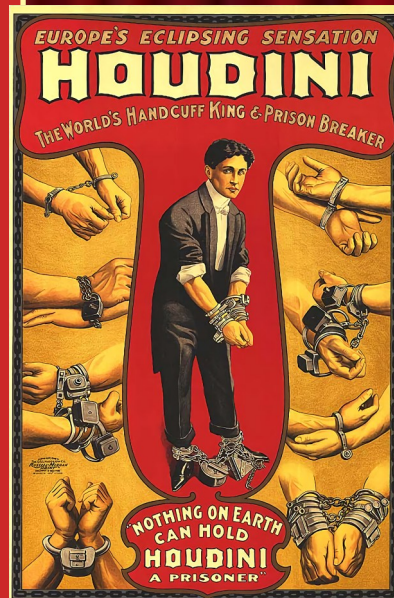
