
9. Tiki Republik

1. Arrowhead Queen Tour Boat

3. SkyPark at Santa's Village

Snow Valley has 240 acres to explore and has different experiences for everyone.



5. Snow Summit/Big Bear Mountain (Big Bear Mountain Resorts)

These properties are located in the San Bernardino Mountains and have year-round scenic getaways and high energy outdoor experiences. In the summer, the properties offer a lift-served mountain bike park, hiking trails, a golf course and other family friendly experiences! During the winter, they provide skiers and snowboarders with more than 400 acres, 26 lifts and more than 55 runs.

6. Wildhaven **Reservations required**

Wildhaven Ranch is a wildlife sanctuary that offers a handful of tour options. It's one of the top places to visit while in Lake Arrowhead. This is a perfect place visit if you love animals and want to get an up close encounter with nature's wildlife. Some of the activities you can do here are observing and feeding bears, interacting with animals like raccoons and deer, and viewing other wildlife, like coyotes, native snakes, hawks and more.

7. McKenzie's Waterski School

Reservations on same day or next day activities can be done at the Ski Dock. You can also call ahead to plan your activities for a future date. They have instructors to teach you how to Waterski, Waterboard and Kneeboard. It is a great activity to do with your group!

8. Lake Gregory Inflatable Park 24171 Lake Drive, Crestline

Have a great time at the Lake's Inflatable Water Park. This is a seasonal activity, held during a part of spring and throughout the summer. It usually opens May 25th-September 2nd.



9. Grass Valley Park

Hiking and Walking trails

We suggest downloading "Alltrails" app for different skill trails and maps of trails

1. Forest Overlook via Old Toll Road



This trail is considered an easier skill level. This is a popular 2 mile route for hiking and is also great for walking and running. You can even go snowshoeing too. It's a very peaceful and quiet road. *Dog friendly but dogs must be leashed*

2. Metate Trail

An easy skill level trail too, it is also very peaceful and short. The trail is around 1.7 miles and has beautiful scenery all around. The trail is great for hiking, running and walking. It's a great hike for families with kids.



3 Heart Rock Trail 250 CA-138



Heart Rock Trail is a 1.7 mile heavily tracked loop trail that's located near Cedarpines Park. It features a waterfall and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers different activity options and is accessible year-round. *Dogs can be taken on this trail but will need to be leashed.*

4. Will Abell Memorial Trail

This trail is 1.9 miles long and is considered to be moderately challenging. This is also another popular area for hiking and exploring around the San Bernardino Forest. *This trail is also dog friendly but must be leashed*



5. Devil's Hole OHV Trail



This trail is around 9 miles long or a little less. It is considered to be moderately difficult. It is also a great off-roading area for those interested! It is a single 2.7 mile track.*Note that for off-roading you will need a spark arrester*

6. Pinnacle Trail Parking

CA-173

Arrowhead Pinnacles Trail is a 3.4 mile difficult skill trail that is heavily tracked out and located near Lake Arrowhead. The trail is used for nature trips, bird watching and also features beautiful wildflowers. The trail is accessible year-round and dog friendly.
