Parking for Horse Trailers- reserved parking will be at the most western side of the Melba city park on Baseline Rd. This is at the end of the parade; an easy load and exit when the parade is finished. Please follow signs.

- Horses will be lined up in the parade according to their own desire for placement. Either at the end of the parade, or as they arrive. Please feel free to place yourself where you and your horse are the most comfortable and away from any loud vehicles.
- Line-up: 9:00am Corner of baseline and Southside Rd
 Line-up is according to your arrival and after these vehicles

<u>Judging:</u> <u>9:30am- 10:20am</u> Please be in place if you wish for your entry to be judged

- Parade begins: 10:30am
- Candy is allowed to be thrown into the crowd only, Never on the road as it becomes increasingly dangerous for the children who run out to pick it up.
 Please also be careful of corners. It is getting increasing difficult to manage the crowd.
- <u>-</u> Due to the lack of donations A small fee of <u>\$25.00</u> is being charged <u>only</u> for all **commercial vehicles** who plan to use the parade as advertisement.
