PATH BY THE NUMBERS

Educated over 1380 people about human trafficking - a 250% increase over 2021

During October and November PATH had the opportunity to partner with 3 Goodwill Opportunity Centers throughout the state to raise employee awareness about human trafficking. PATH presented its Human Trafficking 101 program to over 80 employees.

Here's what Jennifer Bergman, Director of Career Services, Lexington Region had to say about the training and partnership with PATH:

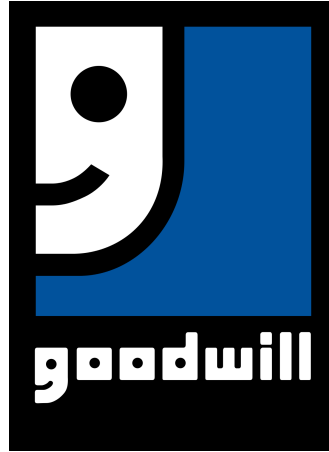
Raising our awareness around human trafficking is a focus and goal for Goodwill starting from the top down. Our leadership recognized that trafficking is an often-overlooked problem and we needed education and resources to understand what it looks like so we can help our clients get out of these types of situations.

When our clients enter our Opportunity Centers, they are looking for help and support and when they see how we can assist them and others around them, it gives them hope. They may come to us for one need but we want to be able to help them and understand what other issues they are facing.

The partnership with PATH has opened our eyes to an issue we may not have known how to recognize and we are actively looking for ways that we can help and what other things we can do, outside of this training, to educate our clients and employees on human trafficking. We look forward to continuing our involvement with PATH into 2023.
