
Traveling This Summer? Be Aware of the Signs of Human Trafficking

Human trafficking can happen anywhere, but transportation hubs such as airports, bus stations, truck stops, and travel centers are particularly vulnerable. Though the crime doesn't always require a border crossing or act of movement, traffickers often take advantage of America's transportation infrastructure to exploit their victims and hide them in plain sight.

Members of the traveling public are in a unique position to recognize and report potential human trafficking situations. If you plan on traveling this summer, be sure to check out the <u>resources</u> offered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Blue Campaign. Your awareness could save a life.

Remember: Do not attempt to confront a suspected trafficker or alert a victim to your suspicions. You can report suspected human trafficking to the Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) tip line at 866-347-2423 or submit a HSI tip form online. If someone is in immediate danger, call 911 or local authorities.
