Pioneer Village Rules

FIRE CODE:

If you need a fire for your demonstration, the tent needs to be fire proofed and a small label attached stating such. Also, if you do your own fire proofing, you need to have the bottle there for the fire chief to see. You must have a fire extinguisher, and your fire must be at least 10 feet away from your tent. Remember, all trash, including <u>all</u> corn stalks, straw bales, and weeds, etc. must be removed from the park. You can use straw for decorations if you have no fire, but straw cannot be used under a roof. **You must bring your own straw for your booth for decorations**; the festival <u>DOES</u> **NOT** provide you with straw. There are dumpsters near the cattle barn (SE corner of park) to put your cardboard in.

SETUP:

You can set up your exhibit on Friday afternoon, or you can begin at 7:00 a.m. Saturday. No tear downs can begin before closing time on Sunday. Exhibits will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. All vehicles are to be out of the area by 9:45 a.m. each day of the festival. No vehicles will be allowed back into the park until 15 minutes <u>after</u> the festival closes each day.

PARKING:

Parking is available in any festival parking area. A limited number of passes are available for vendors to park in the Swindler lot area off Evergreen Road by the cattle barns or the corner of Taylor and Evergreen. Please indicate interest for this pass on your application form (a maximum of one vendor parking pass will be given out to each exhibit).

COSTUMES:

All Participants must be dressed in Pioneer costumes (1890 era). We suggest a long dress or skirt and blouse of calico, small print, or homespun-look cotton material. Duster caps, sun bonnets, aprons and shawls are nice accessories for the women. Pants of canvas, denim overalls or cotton material are suggested for the men. Good colors would be brown, black, or tan. Shirts of white, calico, or neutral color cotton are also appropriate to wear. <u>PLEASE</u>, NO ALUMINUM CHAIRS in the park. A small wooden chair would be in better taste. Try to be as AUTHENTIC as possible with your display.

FEES:

Those persons who will be demonstrating a pioneer craft will not be charged to participate. Those of you who will be selling your items will be assessed a \$25.00 fee by the festival. If you are selling items, you must have a sales tax number, and submit the 7% tax on your sales to the state.

ADMISSION:

Admission into the festival is \$3.00 per adult, \$1.00 for children and students. Children 5 and under are free. An exhibitor will be issued one day passes for you and your workers (normally four (4) passes are given to each exhibitor). The workers' pass will be collected at the gate each day and your hand stamped for you to re-enter during that day. On your application form, please indicate how many you will need, keeping in mind that passes are valid for one day only.
