## Forks of the Wabash Pioneer Festival Engines and Tractors Rules

### **SETUP:**

You can set up your exhibit on Friday afternoon, or you can begin at 7:00 a.m. Saturday. No tear downs can begin before closing time on Sunday. Exhibits will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. All vehicles are to be out of the area by 9:45 a.m. each day of the festival. No vehicles will be allowed back into the park until 15 minutes **after** the festival closes each day to allow visitors to leave the festival. You are encouraged to park in the lot on the corner of Evergreen and Taylor Streets.

#### **PARKING:**

Parking is available in any festival parking area. A limited number of passes are available for vendors to park in the Swindler lot area off Evergreen Road by the cattle barns and in vendor lot on the corner of Evergreen and Taylor Street. Please indicate interest for this pass on your registration form (only one vendor parking pass will be given out to each participant).

#### **ADMISSION:**

Four (4) wristbands will be given to each vendor. The wristbands will be your admission to the festival all weekend and must be shown to the workers at the gates as you enter the fairgrounds each day. They must be always worn during the festival.

Sunday morning worship service will begin at 9:00 a.m.

#### FIRE CODE:

You must have a fire extinguisher, and your fire must be at least 10 feet away from your tent. Remember, all trash, including <u>all</u> corn stalks and weeds, etc. must be removed from the park. You can use straw for decorations if you have no fire, but straw cannot be used under a roof. There are dumpster near the cattle barn (SE corner of park) to put your trash in. WE MUST COMPLY with these rules.
