Please complete the following form in order that you or a member of your immediate family (spouse or child) may become a candidate for a Western Pennsylvania Water Pollution Control Association (WPWPCA) Academic Scholarship. We ask that you be as accurate as possible knowing that any false or misleading information may disqualify you from consideration.

Please be assured that all information will be treated with the strictest confidence.

Please note that only a member of the WPWPCA or their immediate family members (spouse, or child) are eligible to apply for this academic scholarship. Applications may be submitted for the same individual, multiple years provided the sponsor member remains in good standing with the Association. The limit for award to an applicant is four (4) awards.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS:

The academic scholarship committee is composed of members of The WPWPCA. The WPWPCA President, the Scholarship committee members and their immediate family members are not eligible for the Academic Scholarship. The committee reviews all applications turned in by the deadline. The academic endowment committee will not consider late and/or incomplete applications. Each applicant is numerically "scored" based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Academic accomplishment
- 2. Activity and involvement in school, work and the community
- 3. Essay question response
- 4. Member activities with WPWPCA
- 5. Committee interview

The committee may interview up to five (5) applicants based on the scoring on the first four (4) items above. Each applicant's interview, if conducted, will be ranked and added to the total score of the first four (4) items above to obtain a cumulative total score. The full board of directors of the WPWPCA shall award scholarships with a maximum award of \$2,500.00 each or multiple awards for a maximum combined total value of \$5,000.00 each per year among the deserving applicants awarded scholarships based on the recommendation of academic scholarship committee yielded from the scoring criteria above. The WPWPCA reserves the right to not award the scholarship as warranted.

Only applicants receiving the award will be notified. Notification of award will be made subsequent to the WPWPCA September meeting of the full board of directors.
