

The idolatry problem

When the doctor Nose Nada entered the Room of Hidden Secrets, the assembled crowd got up and applauded with enthusiasm. He was received as a hero. His black hair, well combed, along with gray hair on each side of his head, add prestige to his person. He was assigned to investigate religious people who believe in gods with lowercase "g". The reason for the warm applause is due to unconfirmed rumors that he discovered everything related to the outpouring of the Spirit of God. The doctor, although he has an athlete's body, is lame and deaf. In his right hand, as he approaches the witness stand, he brings his hearing aid. It's a bull's horn!

The work of investigating religions that worship "gods with lowercase "g" was a colossal task. The world is saturated with religions with gods with lowercase "g". Under his command, a "legion" of employees of THE CONSORTIUM visited the different religions of the world. The rumors are that he... discovered... the answers.

The attorney, after greeting the doctor and welcoming him, asked him to identify himself.

“Please give your name.”

"Nose Nada", said the doctor.

Once again, the crowd applauded.

THE CONSORTIUM is proud of polytheism. Most religions in the world, more than 4,000 different groups, are polytheistic. Religions is a favorite weapon of THE CONSORTIUM. Through them, the management of the powerful company confuses humanity. Many of the deceived do not see the difference between religion and Christianity.

Religion is man's attempt to get closer to God, while Christianity is

God's attempt to get closer to man.

The report prepared by Nose Nada divides the gods with lowercase "g" into two groups: "polytheism" and "monotheism". The largest group of gods with lowercase "g" is identified as polytheists and the smallest as monotheists. All demons know that "religiosity" infects the world and benefits the Empire of Darkness. If humans are unaware of this truth, THE CONSORTIUM is out of danger.

The attorney began his interrogation by asking:

“What is the difference between polytheism and monotheism?”

The doctor placed the bull's horn in his ear, and asked:

“What did you say?”

The attorney patiently, raised his voice and asked again:

“Who are the polytheists?”

The doctor responded with great pride and satisfaction:

“Those who believe in many gods with a lowercase "g".

The attorney with genuine interest asked:

“Who are the monotheists?”

Upon hearing this word, the doctor's affable face hardened. Under this category there are two groups, one of the groups, believes in the God with a capital “G” and the other group believes in the god of Zoroastrianism (Note 1). The second group is part of THE CONSORTIUM. Using a tone that reveals hatred, the doctor said:

“Monotheists are the ones who believe in one God.”

All religions, related to gods with lowercase "g", belong to the kingdom of Darkness. In all "polytheistic" religions there is a pattern that is repeated with slight variation. The pattern has to do with the ranks or hierarchy of these gods. The attorney asked him to:

“Let's talk about the different ranks at the spiritual level,”

In a tone steeped in pride, the doctor said:

“In total... there are four ranks or categories.”

Polytheistic churches use the same scheme that THE CONSORTIUM uses for their chain of command. There are a total of four ranks among the gods with lowercase "g":

One: Primary one. The highest rank belongs to the Rulers.

Two: Secondary one. The second intermediate belongs to the level of the Authorities.

Three: Minor ones. The third rank belongs to the Powers.

Four: Lower ones. The fourth and last rank belongs to the "forces of evil in the heavenly regions."

The doctor visited all the polytheistic religions of the world. It was an exhausting job! He claims to have found evidence related to the outpouring of the Spirit of God. In presenting his report, he left the highlight of his investigation, for the end.

The investigation of doctor Nose Nada was complicated when studying monotheists. The report prepared by the doctor identifies in four groups, those who believe in one God. These groups are known as Zoroastrianism, Islam, Judaism and Christians. Placed in chronological order; the oldest religion is Judaism, followed by Zoroastrianism (between 628 and 551 BC), then Christianity and the most recent is Islam (613 A.D.). Zoroastrianism alone works 100 percent for THE CONSORTIUM.

"The founder of Zoroastrianism is an Iranian named Zoroaster," the doctor says.

In his report Nose Nada explains that Zoroastrianism is known as the religion of the good life and is represented by the god with lowercase "g" called Ahura Mazda. This religion has three basic commandments: Good thoughts, Good words, and Good deeds. Disguised as good intentions, Zoroastrianism hides its diabolical intentions. Its approach is that man does not need God to overcome evil with good.

Nose Nada, showing satisfaction on his face, said:

“Ramifications of this movement, today, are known as "self-help."

Judaism and Islam are different, but they have many things in common. These two religions speak of an ALMIGHTY God, creator of the heavens and the Earth. Both religions consider "works" as the key to entering heaven and reject Jesus Christ as the Son of God. Christianity replaces works with belief. Those who believe in Jesus Christ will enter heaven.

The most dangerous religions for THE CONSORTIUM are Jews and Christians. They reject the "idols". The GREAT BOOK reveals:

"The whole human race is foolish and has no knowledge! The craftsmen are disgraced by the idols they make, for their carefully shaped works are a fraud. These idols have no breath or power. Idols are worthless; they are ridiculous lies! On the day of punishment, they will all be destroyed. (Jeremiah 10:14-15).

Idols are divided into two categories: material and spiritual. Gods with a lowercase "g" are associated with idols. An example of material idols is money. The bragging doctor said:

“Money tops the list related to modern "idolatry".”

Idols are a good deal for THE CONSORTIUM. It is for this reason that all polytheistic religions promote the use of idols. The GREAT BOOK prohibits having other gods and that implies having idols that represent them. The document reveals:

"I am the LORD your God. I brought you out of Egypt, from the land where you were a slave. Don't have any other gods besides me. Do not make yourself any idol, or anything that bears resemblance to what is in heaven above, or to what is on the earth below, or to what is in the waters under the earth. Do not bow down before them or worship them" (Exodus 20:2-5a).

The doctor's report points out that polytheistic religions are full of idols, which honors THE CONSORTIUM. Humans, who possess

idols, travel on crooked paths. Paths that benefit the powerful company. Twisted roads influence man to turn away from God and encourage in them the production of good quality negative energy.

"The crooked roads are in danger," said Nose Nada.

These short words were like a cold-water bath... that surprised... the demons.

Note:

1. This movement began in Iran and existed before Islam dominated Iran. It was founded by the prophetic reformer Zoroaster, approximately between the 6th-17th centuries before Jesus Christ. This religion has survived until the 21st century in isolated areas of Iran and is also practiced in some parts of India (especially in Mumbai). Today, Zoroastrianism has resurfaced under the New Age movement, being the same demons with different names.
