

Power, Love and Justice

Next to the platform, where the members of the High Council are sitting, is the dark area. It's like a thick curtain of darkness that descends from the ceiling to the floor. The dark space it covers is a square that is three meters wide by three meters long. The darkness, inside the square, is dense and sticky. Inside is Tolerance, the horrible creature, with the face and tail of the Komodo dragon. So far, the ugly creature has kept quiet, but he started grumbling when the doctor brought up the subject of "tithing." Those attending the meeting realized, the disgust of Tolerance, as they observe flashes of lightning in the interior of the darkness. The crisis worsened as a result of the doctor's comment on saying:

"The plagues... were not sent... to punish the Egyptians."

Hidden in the dark zone, Tolerance began to murmur between teeth, and to growl uncontrollably. attorney Odeim, ignoring the uncomfortable noises, continued his interrogation. He asked:

"Why do you say that the plagues... were not sent... to punish the Egyptians?"

Most members of THE CONSORTIUM are unaware of the secret behind these disastrous plagues. They think that the purpose of the plagues was to punish the Egyptians and their pharaoh. This thought is far from the truth!

"The intention of the plagues... was to attack... THE CONSORTIUM."

These words surprised all those attending the meeting and were considered an exaggeration. Tolerance, who knows the truth, trembled! God's intention with a capital "G" when sending the plagues was to ridicule and humiliate the gods with lowercase "g" that reigned in Egypt. The doctor in a tone that reveals hatred said:

"The ten plagues were the result of a well-thought-out plan on the

part of God.”

The boos were immediately heard in the room as a result of this uncomfortable comment.

What happened to the plagues was a strategy to ridicule THE CONSORTIUM. As the plagues progressed, they increased in intensity and complexity. In the beginning, the magicians, sorcerers and wise men of Egypt copied the first plagues. They did it halfway, but they never matched them! The first plagues amazed the Egyptians, but not the gods with lowercase "g". These entities, intervening behind the magicians, sorcerers and wise men of Egypt, reproduced the plagues on a smaller scale. As new plagues emerged, the problem reached alarming levels, because no "god" in Egypt could stop them. As the plagues increased in intensity, the prosperous Egyptian economy began to collapse.

Demons are evil, but not stupid. After the first four plagues, the gods with lowercase "g" came to the conclusion of letting the Israelites out of Egypt. At that moment, something unexpected happened, which frightened the management of the powerful company. They lost control of Pharaoh!

His disobedience... opened the doors... for the plagues to hit Egypt.

The doctor Nose Nada, whose nickname is No-no, in his investigation discovered the alarming truth related to Pharaoh's disobedience. Associates are like sheep dogs, who help the farmer keep livestock in order. For this alliance to work perfectly, both minds must be synchronized. This harmony was broken, when the God with capital "G" did something, which the demons considered impossible. Intrigued Odeim asked:

“What happened to Pharaohs?”

The doctor, without measuring his words, threw them without restrictions.

“God hardened Pharaoh's heart.”

This truth does not cause a stir among humans, but is a cause for panic among demons. These words were the straw that shed the wrath of Tolerance. Lightning in the darkness increased in frequency and intensity. Confused with the comment, the lawyer asked:

“What do you mean that God hardened Pharaoh's heart?”

As explained by the doctor, the gods with lowercase "g" could not control Pharaoh's mind because Almighty God hardened his heart. Pharaoh's disobedience creates a dangerous precedent. The attorney tried to consecrate himself with his superiors by commenting:

“Pharaoh's stubbornness is responsible for not letting the Israelites go.”

"It's not true," the doctor replied.

It is God who hardened Pharaoh's heart to disobey the gods with lowercase "g". This is the truth, that the members of THE CONSORTIUM are unaware of. In the doctor's report, there is a photo copy of a very old manuscript that reads:

"I am going to harden Pharaoh's heart, and although I will do many miraculous signs and wonders in Egypt, he will not listen. Then I will pour out my power over Egypt; with great acts of righteousness I will bring out the armies of my people, the Israelites. And when I unfold my power against Egypt and bring out the Israelites from there, the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD" (Exodus 7:3-5).

Tolerance wallowed with rage, into the darkness, because the truth was exposed. The excuse among the demons, to justify the ten plagues, was Pharaoh's hardened heart. It's a half-truth! The ten plagues came as the result of a direct attack to the gods with lowercase "g", who reigned in Egypt. The most alarming thing about this attack is that it was the God with a capital "G", who hardened Pharaoh's heart. Doctor Nose Nada in a tone that reveals anxiety said:

"Pharaoh's hardened heart... opened the doors... to the plagues."

These words, due to their implications, provoked absolute silence in the room. The doctor added:

"God used the plagues... to reveal His POWER... His LOVE and His JUSTICE" (Note 1).

Of these three attributes, the "Justice of God" is the least considered by Christians.

The doctor dedicated an entire chapter, in his report, to talk about the righteousness of God. Demons do not like to talk about this issue because it is a source of blessing. It is for this reason that the Great Book recommends:

"You shall follow righteousness and only righteousness, so that you can live and possess the land that the Lord your God gives you" (Deuteronomy 16:20).

Justice is more valuable than material wealth. This truth infuriates demons. The Great Book states:

"In the day of wrath it is useless to be rich, but righteousness frees from death" (Proverbs 11:4).

As soon as the doctor mentioned that justice occupies an important place in the Kingdom of God, those attending the meeting went crazy with rage and began booing. Even the horrible creature inside the dark zone shook because of the doctor's comment:

"The Lord hates the way of the wicked, but loves those who follow righteousness" (see Proverbs 15:9).

The straw that broke the camel's back is related to the note read in relation to the third heaven, where God dwells. It is written:

"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of food or drink, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit" (Romans 14:17).

The doctor paused briefly and in a tone that reveals concern he said:

"We must not allow... Christians... to discover the importance of

justice."

The doctor warns, in his report, of the danger posed by allowing Christians to "grow in the knowledge of God." Those who succeed, discover the importance of justice. It activates the creative and transforming power of God. It is written:

"Rather, seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33).

The DC (deceive and confuse) division has done an excellent job of entangling Christians so that they do not "understand" the importance of justice. As long as they are confused, in their thoughts opposed to God, they do not take over the peace related to God's justice. The truth is that, just as the wicked does not escape his punishment, the righteous man does not escape his reward. God's "justice" guarantees the righteous man his reward. It is written:

"For God will repay each one according to what his works deserve" (Romans 2:6).

Focusing on the justice of God... the doctor... discovered a clue that led him to answer the four questions. The clue has to do with Abraham... whom God... declared him righteous by his faith. Talking about this man was like throwing "gasoline" into the fire... it was revived. Boos increased more vigorously!

What happened to Abraham is an embarrassment for THE CONSORTIUM.

Notes:

1. Power, Love and Justice

Power: God increased the intensity of the plagues until he humiliated THE CONSORTIUM. The Lord is POWERFUL! Even the impossible is possible for Him! The plagues destroyed the great Egyptian empire.

Love: God protected the Israelites from the calamities that the Egyptians experienced. Today, the Christian church speaks enthusiastically of God's

Love and His Power. These two attributes are considered extremely important. Not so His Justice! Talking about it is like walking in a minefield; a bad step can make everything explode.

Justice: It is the foundation of God's throne. It is written: "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne, and your heralds, love and truth" (Psalms 89:14 NIV). The fact that Pharaoh did not allow His People to leave, allowed God to activate His Justice, and send the ten plagues.
