

# Abraham and Moses

**T**he subject related to Abraham is very controversial among the demons. What happened around this man reveals the cleverness of God and exposes the clumsiness of the Empire of Darkness. His story is an ugly embarrassment to the lowercase-g gods of the Sumerians. Remembering this cruel event is a painful and frustrating experience for the demons. The lawyer, aware of the sensitivity of the subject, asked:

“In your report... you claim... that the "Sumerian" gods were humiliated.”

The bad-humored doctor answered and said:

“Not only the Sumerian gods... the gods of the Egyptians... were also humiliated.”

In the Dark Zone, Tolerance looks like a boiler, about to explode. He experienced in his own flesh, the humiliation of the Sumerian and Egyptian gods (Note 1). In his frustration he was about to come out of the darkness, but he restrained himself. The attorney asked:

“How important are the Sumerians?”

The short response from the doctor was:

“Abraham belongs to the Sumerians.”

The truth is that it is not known if the Sumerians come from Mesopotamia or if they emigrated from other territories. What is known is that they settled in the area, which currently corresponds for the most part, to the Republic of Iraq. Mesopotamia is considered the cradle of civilization! Abraham comes from the "Sumerian" culture and despite believing in many gods, the only true God recruited him. The term "Sumerian" comes from Sumer and is the common name given to the ancient inhabitants of lower

Mesopotamia. They called themselves "sag-giga," which literally means "the people with black heads."

The story of Abraham can be compared to scoring a "goal", while the goalkeeper is entertained looking the other way. An easy victory for the winning team but humiliating for the losing team. The demons are in the losing team! In a tone full of anger and frustration, the doctor said:

“The gods with a lowercase "g" did not prevent it.”

"What... didn't they prevent it?" the attorney asked.

“They did not prevent God with a capital "G" from recruiting Abraham.”

“Why didn't they stop it?”

“They underestimated the power of God.”

When the gods with lowercase "g" heard of Abraham's selection, instead of worrying, they laughed out loud. Several factors provoked mockery in relation to this citizen of the Sumerian empire. First, he was too old for the mission, since he was 75 years old and secondly, he had no children. The doctor added:

“In addition, his wife was too old to get pregnant.”

The God with a capital "G" gave Abraham a promise, which defies logic, because he promised him that in his old age, he would have a son. It is one thing to receive a promise that seems ridiculous and quite another to wait for it, without allowing the negative imagination to take control. Abraham was 75 years old when he received the promise, and it was fulfilled when he was 99 years old. Uncomfortable with the issue, the doctor added:

“There is a promise... that bothers... every demon.”

“What is that promise?”

“Through Abraham all the families of the earth will be blessed.”

These words were like adding salt to the wound because it made all the demons gathered in the Room of Hidden Secrets scream with

rage. It bothers demons, not having prevented the recruitment of Abraham. Through this man, THE CONSORTIUM was humiliated twice. The first time has to do with the people of Israel who proclaim themselves the people of God. Abraham is their founder!

Secondly, he ridiculed the Sumerian gods, by making the splendor of this people disappear. Today, the Sumerians have disappeared, and the Egyptians have also lost their splendor, but the Israelites have flourished and prospered. The fact that this insignificant group of slaves, identified as the People of God, has not disappeared from history, causes rage and uncontrolled tantrums among the management of the powerful enterprise.

In a tone that reveals frustration mixed with anger, the doctor said:

“The Jews are a stone in the shoe for THE CONSORTIUM.”

**M**any demons in their stubbornness deny that Jews are a problem for the Empire of Darkness. Reality confirms it! As learned by Odeim, from the evidence in Dadlam's possession, the Jews represent the "prophetic clock of God." There is a divine plan, in which the Jews, along with the Christian church, are an important part. The future of humanity is intimately linked to the Israelites.

At the beginning of his investigation, attorney Odeim was reluctant to accept this truth. As he learned in detail, the evidence extracted from the Garden of Wisdom, he began to accept that the Israelites are different from other peoples. A good example of this truth is related to oil. Possessing it marks a contrast between the Arabs and the Israelites. Having oil implies wealth. The Arabs have oil and not the Israelites. In this place, according to the information obtained, the Spirit of God was poured out. We are talking about a huge rock about 50 feet high, which hides an impressive and glorious miracle.
