

Engineer Casi Puedo

Casi Puedo (which means Almost Can in Spanish) is the name of the Engineer and his nickname is CP. He is tall and very heavy. His overweight causes him to lose balance and when he walks, he staggers from one side to the other. As the engineer approached the stage, walking like a penguin, the booing began to subside. CP wears a white coat like the doctors, but much shorter. The coat reaches his waist and the pockets, on both sides of his chest, are filled with different colored pens.

The thick lenses of the engineer's eyeglasses testify to his acute myopia and provide a certain air of intellectual. His broad bald spot adds years to him and makes him look older than he really is. Of all the members, of the Advisory group, the engineer is the most proud and arrogant devil. He was one of the few demons, who maintained his friendship with Dadlam, after he returned from the Garden of Wisdom.
