


The book of 1 Peter-I have a video summary of first Peter

1Pet 1:1-5

- 1 PETER, an apostle of Y'shua Messiah, to the pilgrims of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,
- 2 elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Y'shua Messiah: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.
- 3 Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Y'shua Messiah, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Y'shua Messiah from the dead,
- 4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,
- 5 who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Here in the first 5 verses of chapter 1, Peter is giving us his ministry business card -PETER, an apostle of Y'shua Messiah —He was called by Y'shua not a self-made Apostle like some of the bio's and business card we see today? He also tells us we have a living hope because of Messiah resurrection, and we are kept by the power of YHWH though faith to salvation — Peter, like Paul, was teaching the resurrection of the dead and the inheritance. He also cites Y"shua as proof of the resurrection.

WHEN Peter SAYS "an inheritance?" He means the land which is where we will be at the resurrection (Ex. 15:17, Deut 4:21, 38, Psalm 74:2, 79:1, Ezek. 47:13-14). Peter knew that the inheritance is the land of Israel which will be given to His people forever.

I say let's live our life as we have a hope and a future because we do!! - let's continue next slide.

1Pet 1:6-12

6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 that the genuineness of your faith, [being] much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Y'shua Messiah, 8 whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see [Him,] yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, 9 receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of [your] souls. 10 Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace [that would come] to you, 11 searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Messiah who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Messiah and the glories that would follow. 12 To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into.

In vs 6- 12, Peter acknowledges that His people have been through various trials. "Faith" used here is the Greek word pistis. It is much better translated as "faithfulness." He states that their faithfulness to the Scriptures & Y'shua is more precious than gold which is purified by fire.


1 Pet 1:10: The prophets knew of the grace and salvation by Y'shua that would come to us (Dan. 2:44, Gen. 49:10). 1 Pet 1:12: The prophets knew they were not serving themselves but were serving those who were not even yet born. The

testimony of the visions of the prophets speaks of this. And imagine the Angels desire to look into-We are chosen and Blessed Family.

1Pet 1:13-21 (NKJV)

13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest [your] hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Y'shua Messiah; 14 as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, [as] in your ignorance; 15 but as He who called you [is] holy, you also be holy in all [your] conduct, 16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy." 17 And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay [here] in fear; 18 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, [like] silver or gold, from your aimless conduct [received] by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Messiah, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. 20 He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you 21 who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

Based upon our new birth, we should be led to practical obedience and growth in holiness. Interesting that 1 Pet 1:16: says We are to be setapart in ALL our behavior. Peter is quoting the part of Torah that pertains to the Levitical diet among a few other things-lets look at that,- next slide

If there is anyone who does not know of the Dietary Laws, go read as your homework- Lev chapter 11

1 Pet 1:18-19: We are no longer redeemed with the 1/2 shekel that was to be given to the Temple for atonement as in (Ex. 30:13-16). We are redeemed with the precious blood of Messiah. Therefore, we are to act like it. And here is the beauty of this! All we have to do is yield or surrender to the leading the spirit and his word, because Our faithfulness isn't from our own work, but it is from YHWH through the death and resurrection of the Messiah.

1Pet 1:22-25 22 Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, 23 having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, 24 because "All flesh [is] as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away, 25 But the word of YHWH endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.

READ HERE

1 Pet 1:23: Our souls are purified through obedience to Torah and all the scriptures from Genesis to revelation (Acts 6:7, Romans 1:4-5, Heb. 5:9).

1 Pet 1:25: Peter reminds us that we are to be in obedience to the Word of YHWH in everything we do. The word of Yahweh abides forever. This is a quote from Isa. 40:7-8. But the fact that the Word of the Father is forever is spoken of many times in Scripture (Psalm 119:89, 142, 144, 152, 160, Luke 16:17).

Ok so what are some life lessons from chapter 1 next slide



- apart, Holy in All our life we are to be a Peculiar people a holy people-our lives need to show it, we should talk and act differently then the world and the Religious world. Let's live as though We have hope and a future because we do!!
- 2) Trials & Testing's- We are going to be tested and have trails in our lives especially if you are praying and asking YHWH to change you

and Lead you and Strengthen you and make you more like Y'shua – we will cover this more in chapter 4

- 3) Joy- lets have an altar call —so many times many of us don't live with Joy-we wear life on our face and shoulders —we should have more joy than anyone —now I understand we have times in our lives, but I mean don't stay their get the Joy of YHWH it is our strength- we are to have joy unspeakable.
- 4.) Obey YHWH- I have said before that Torah is death if it is without Messiah —that means we should Obey the Torah because we love YHWH and have Messiah Y'shua and that leads us to life here on Earth as we obey HIS word (following His instructions) and eternal life at the resurrection. In others words we don't really know how to live a full life of Joy, Peace, and contentment in trails and testing's unless we follow YAH's word and Have His Spirit in us by having the Messiah led and guide us.

Ok let's go to chapter 2

1Pet 2:1-10

1 Therefore, <u>laying aside</u> all <u>malice</u>, all <u>deceit</u>, <u>hypocrisy</u>, <u>envy</u>, and all <u>evil speaking</u>, 2 as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, 3 if indeed you have tasted that the Lord [is] gracious. 4 Coming to Him [as to] a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God [and] precious, 5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Y'shua Messiah. 6 Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture, "Behold, I lay in Zion A chief cornerstone, elect, precious, And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame." 7 Therefore, to you who believe, [He is] precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone," 8 and "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed. 9 But <u>you [are] a chosen generation</u>, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, <u>His own special people</u>, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 who once [were] not a people but [are] now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

1Pet 2:11-17

11 Beloved, <u>I beg [you]</u> as sojourners and pilgrims, <u>abstain from fleshly lusts</u> which war against the soul, 12 having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by [your] good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation. 13 Therefore <u>submit yourselves</u> to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme, 14 or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and [for the] praise of those who do good. 15 For <u>this is the will of God</u>, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men— 16 as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God. 17 <u>Honor all [people.]</u> Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.

1Pet 2:18-25

18 Servants, [be] submissive to [your] masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh. 19 For this [is] commendable, if because of conscience toward God one endures grief, suffering wrongfully. 20 For what credit [is it] if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this [is] commendable before God. 21 For to this you were called, because Messiah also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: 22 "Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth"; 23 who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed [Himself] to Him who judges righteously; 24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. 25 For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

What are some life lesson for chapter 2 next slide



- 1) laying aside –all malice- is wrongful intention or the intention or desire to do evil; ill will., all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, desire the word, so you can grow and become mature- we need to stop being spiritual Babies –take our spiritual diapers off and start taking responsibility for our poopy stuff.
- 2) abstain from fleshly lusts –Stay away from those things we know we shouldn't do or participate with

- 3) Will of YAH-.Submit to those in authority-Bosses and all -doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men—and if you endures grief, suffering wrongfully that brings us to # 4
- 4) Patient--it says when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently this will glorifies our Father when we handle it property and not get all fleshly (Carnal)- lets all allow Yah to change us by being transform by the renewing of our Mind —lets start doing what we know we shoud do by the Power of the Spirit.

Ok chapter 3

1Pet 3:1-12 1 Wives, likewise, [be] submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, 2 when they observe your chaste conduct [accompanied] by fear. 3 Do not let your adornment be [merely] outward-arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on [fine] apparel- 4 rather [let it be] the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible [beauty] of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God. 5 For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, 6 as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good and are not afraid with any terror. 7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with [them] with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as [being] heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered. 8 Finally, all [of you be] of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, [be] tenderhearted, [be] courteous; 9 not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing. 10 For "He who would love life And see good days, Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit. 11 Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it. 12 For the eyes of YHWH [are] on the righteous, And His ears [are open] to their prayers; But the face of YHWH [is] against those who do evil."

1Pet 3:13-22

13 And who [is] he who will harm you if you become followers of what is good? 14 But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, [you are] blessed. "And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled." 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always [be] ready to [give] a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; 16 having a good conscience, that when they defame you as evildoers, those who revile your good conduct in Messiah may be ashamed. 17 For [it is] better, if it is the will of God, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil. 18 For Messiah also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, 19 by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison, 20 who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while [the] ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water. 21 There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Y'shua Messiah, 22 who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him.

Here we have encouragement to keep dong righteous even if you suffer you are blessed-but I want to cover vs 19 & 20

A common belief stemming from this passage is that after He died, Y'shua preached the Gospel to those who had died, giving them an opportunity to repent. There are some problems with this interpretation, that is for another teaching but if you want the info I can give it to you later.

1) Prayers Hinder when we don't agree 2) Your Tongue 3) seek peace 4) Study and don't take mans word alone

- 1) Prayers Hinder when we don't agree
- 2) Your Tongue-refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit. 11 -Let him turn away from evil and do good; that brings us to
- 3) Seek Peace-Let him seek peace and pursue it.

Again this is about us being Mature Believers and being change and transformed and be more like Y'shua ok chapter 4

1Pet 4:1-11 (NKJV)

1 Therefore, since Messiah suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, 2 that he no longer should live the rest of [his] time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. 3 For we [have spent] enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles-when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. 4 In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with [them] in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of [you.] 5 They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. 6 For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. 7 But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers. 8 And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." 9 [Be] hospitable to one another without grumbling. 10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. 11 If anyone speaks, [let him] [speak] as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, [let him do it] as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Y'shua Messiah, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1Pet 4:12-19 (NKJV)

12 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; 13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Messiah's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. 14 If you are reproached for the name of Messiah, blessed [are you,] for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. 15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. 16 Yet if [anyone suffers] as a **Christian**, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter. 17 For the time [has come] for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if [it begins] with us first, what will [be] the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" 19 Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls [to Him] in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.

Ok I got one word underlined and bold what is it? I want to talk about it because many of us don't even want to be called that?

The Word Christian comes from a root word in Greek

G5546 Χριστιανός Christianos (chriy-stiy-a-nos') n/g.

- 1. (literally, familial) "Little Anointed" (as family name of endearment, like "Little Johnny" or "Little Susie").
- 2. (properly, only of the redeemed) a Little <u>Kinsman of Anointed-One</u> (a relative by the redemptive <u>blood of the Messiah</u>, also called Christ).
- 3. (by Hebraic prophecy) a <u>Redeemed Kinsman of Anointed-One</u> (see Isaiah 62:12).
- 4. (figuratively, as understood by the nations) followers of the teachings of Christ.
- 5. (improperly, though very common) a person who identifies himself as a Christian only because he does not identify with another religion.
- 6. (transliterated, singular) "Christian" (anglicized), "Christianos" (from Greek).
- 7. (transliterated, plural) "Christians" (anglicized), "Christianous" (from Greek).

But this root word comes from another root word

The Word <u>Christian</u> comes from a root word in Greek G5547 Χριστός Christos (chriy-stos') n/p. 1. (literally) Anointed, a man anointed with oil (for a set purpose). 2. (properly) the Messiah, the Anointed-One of the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. 3. (transliterated) "Christ" (anglicized), "Christos" (from Greek). 4. (by function) the (kinsman) Redeemer, the Savior. 5. (by identity) Jesus, Yeshua, Ἰησοῦς, יְהוֹשֵׁע. יְהוֹשֵׁע.

So my observation is that if some says Y'shua we understand by the Identity of the name —but if some says Jesus and are still meaning the Messiah the anointed one of the God of Abraham Isaac and Jacob we are talking about the same person!! But the reason I try to say Y'shua is to help me get out of the Greek mind set- so I say Messiah instead of Christ —even thou they mean the same!! It is training my Mind —So it is ok to say being a Christian but it is ok if you want to say Believer in Messiah or Torah observant —but let's

not be judgmental if someone does not think or say exactly like you do as long as we are taking of the same Messiah. Ok life lesson

Ok start chapter 5

1Pet 5:1-9 1 The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Messiah, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: 2 Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; 3 nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock; 4 and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away. 5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to [your] elders. Yes, all of [you] be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble." 6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. 8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9 Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

1Pet 5:10-14 (NKJV)

10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Messiah Y'shua, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle [you.] 11 To Him [be] the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. 12 By Silvanus, our faithful brother as I consider him, I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is the true grace of God in which you stand. 13 She who is in Babylon, elect together with [you,] greets you; and [so does] Mark my son. 14 Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to you all who are in Messiah Y'shua. Amen.

LIFE LESSONS CHAPTER 5 1) Be Humble 2) Be submissive to each other 3) Cast your cares on YHWH 4) Resist the Devil in power of YHWH

- 1) Be Humble= If we will learn to be Humble YWHW will exalt us —He will takes us from Glory to Glory!! In other words don't try so hard to make everyone think you are somebody —but if you will serve Yah and serve other YAH will let everyone know you are His and are very Precious to Him and to everyone else.
- 2) Be submissive to each other-it also say to the elders those older than you in age and in the

faith -YHWH resist the Proud but gives grace to the humble." So lets learn to be submissive and Humble

- 3) Cast your cares on YHWH-How many times to we give something to YHWH —and then take it right back from Him-lets learn to Trust Him and walk in His Will to our best ability.
- 4) Resist the Devil in power of YHWH-He is always looking for the weak —the isolated the wounded this is why you all are important we are not in this battle alone we have eachother ad we have the King of Kings and Lord of Lord we have victory in Him —you are am overcomer in Messiah —He has overcome the World so we can too.
