

Packing Supplies Checklist

Sturdy Boxes (Various Sizes) You'll need small, medium, and large boxes to fit everything from books to kitchenware to bedding
Packing Tape Durable packing tape is essential for securing your boxes. Make sure it's high-quality to keep boxes from splitting during transit.
Bubble Wrap or Packing Paper Protect fragile items like dishes, glassware, and electronics with bubble wrap or packing paper. Both provide cushioning to prevent breakage.
Markers and Labels Clearly label each box with its contents and the room it belongs in. This will help you stay organized and make unpacking much easier.
Cushioning Blankets or Towels Use soft blankets or towels to wrap delicate or oddly shaped items. This saves space, add protection, and reduces the need for extra packing materials.
Stretch Wrap Plastic stretch wrap is perfect for bundling furniture, securing drawers, or wrapping large items to prevent scratches or damage.
Furniture Pads or Blankets Protect large pieces of furniture from nicks and scratches with furniture pads or moving blankets. These will keep your furniture safe during transit.
