Milestones Achieved

- Formed a dedicated **Project Management Team** and an **Interior Design Team** to oversee every detail.
- Completed **soil borings, boundary surveys, and topographic studies** to ensure the land is ready for construction.
- Finalized **architectural and structural design** with Hutchinson Engineering.
- Completed **electrical design** plans through Adams Electric.
- Secured **full state approval**, marking a major milestone in the process.

Collaboration in Action

Our partnerships with Habitat for Humanity and the Walworth County Lions Clubs are already helping bring community impact full circle. We're also pursuing multiple grant opportunities to expand our base of support.

Campaign Progress

As of March 1, 2026, we have secured \$2 million of our \$6 million goal. We're engaging several major donors as well as the community. Our goal is to raise 75% (\$4.5M) by fall of 2026, positioning us to break ground by spring 2027. Additional financing options have been explored and are available to help us complete the project as needed.
