## (I Peter 1:15 – "But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;")

- I. The duty of the wife (I Peter 3:1-6)
  - a. A submission to their husbands
  - i. The \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 1a): The wife should lovingly, cheerfully, and willingly herself to God's ordained chain-of-authority within the marriage/family. She should acknowledge her husband as the of the family. (Ephesians 5:22 – "*Wives, submit yourselves unto your own* husbands, as unto the Lord.") i. This applies whether or not the husband is ii.
