Fire Chief's Take Away Message

These two structure fires, both in Harmony Township, both three days apart, provide empirical evidence of the need for on-duty firefighters in both Marengo and Chesterville fire stations, 24/7/365.

After a preliminary review of the 911 recordings, 911 data sheets, and my vehicle Dashcam, I am releasing the initial results of the two fires we experienced in our district last month.

After reviewing both structure fires and their outcomes, the following can be reasonably assumed:

- Marengo and Chesterville fire stations are the closest and most appropriate fire stations to respond into Harmony Township.
- Early morning fire responses are difficult times for both BWJFD and other mutual aid fire departments to get an effective response.
- When firefighters are on duty in the fire station, the out-the-door time is significantly reduced.
- When firefighters are on duty at the fire station, the arrival time is significantly reduced.
- An on-duty crew in Chesterville would have arrived at the Road 25 fire in less than 9 minutes from the 911 call and would have increased the victim's chance of survival.
- The first 4 BWJFD members who responded to the Road 25 fire were:
 - o Level 2 FF (Chief Lovell) arrived in 9 minutes and 16 seconds
 - o Level 1 FF with 3 months experience arrived in 22 minutes, 6 seconds
 - Fire Cadet (no formal training certifications) arrived in 38 minutes and 26 seconds
 - o Level 2 FF who arrived 40 minutes after dispatch.
- The on-duty crew in Marengo provided a faster response to Road 187 fire which resulted in less property damage and no civilian casualties.
