TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be Affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Player Member or be a Member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
3. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament.
4. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
5. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
6. Competitors may be asked to umpire all group matches. All knockout matches will be umpired by a qualified umpire.
7. Play throughout for all events will be on a knockout basis except for the preliminary rounds of each singles event, which will be on a group basis. In a group or "round robin" competition each member of the group shall compete against every other member. Two match points will be awarded for a win, one for a loss in a played match, and zero for an un-played or uncompleted match. The ranking order shall be decided primarily by the number of match points gained. If at the completion of the group two or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points the equality shall be resolved as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
8. All matches will be the best of five games; each game will be up to eleven points.
9. Competitors in Under 18 Events must have been born after 31st December 2001.
Competitors in Under 15 Events must have been born after 31st December 2004.
Competitors in Under 13 events must have been born after 31st December 2006
Competitors in Under 11 events must have been born after 31st December 2008.
10. Rackets will conform to ITTF Regulation 3.2.1.3.
11. Clothing shall comply with Table Tennis England Appendix "C" to rules.(x)
12. At the discretion of the Referee competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables not in use. NO CROSS KNOCKING. Dedicated practice tables will not be available.
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. The preliminary rounds of all events will be played in groups of 3 or 4 players, following which the players finishing first and second will qualify for the championship events and the players finishing third or fourth will qualify for the consolation events. In the event of several non-arrivals resulting in incomplete groups the Referee reserves the right to disband the highest numbered incomplete group and to redistribute the players present in that group among other incomplete groups to fill any vacancies.
15. Decisions on points of fact by an Umpire or Assistant Umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and in any matter not covered by them.
16. Entrants who do not attend the tournament without a reason acceptable to the Referee may be reported to the Table Tennis England.
17. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
18. Doping control tests may take place.
19. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
20. All players will be identified by numbers which must be worn at all times when a competitor is participating in any event.
21. An Assistant Umpire will be appointed for finals only at the Referee's discretion.
22. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
23. Notification will be sent after the draw has been made, notifying competitors of the first match time for each event they have entered, provided they have supplied either an **email address** or a **stamped addressed envelope**.
24. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Entrants must sign the undertaking to “observe regulations, abide by the decisions of the Referee, and fulfil the schedule of play”. **Unsigned entries will not be accepted.**

Cheques should be made payable to “**Plymouth Table Tennis**” and crossed “A/C Payee Only”. The draw will take place on Friday 24th January 2020.

No refunds of entry fees will be given after the draw has taken place

Competitors will be notified of the times of their opening matches; at least 7 days’ notice will be given.

Junior 4-star tournaments - Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out, with the following exception:

For players affiliated to Table Tennis England, valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1-50 in the Rating List current at the closing date, Junior Girls rated 1-32, Cadet Boys rated 1-50 and Cadet Girls rated 1-32 are guaranteed to be accepted. Thereafter, entries will be accepted in order of receipt, with priority given to Boys rated 51-500 and Girls rated 33-250 in the relevant Rating Lists.

VENUE

There is no charge for admission to the venue. Free car parking is available at the Centre at owners’ risk. The café will be open providing hot and cold meals, drinks and snacks. Changing rooms and hot showers are available at the Venue. Smoking is not allowed in any area of the venue.

PLAYING CONDITIONS

Play will be on 11 Joola Duomat tables with JOOLA Flash 3*star white plastic balls, Minimum court size will be 10m by 5m and will have full surrounds. Minimum height of playing area is 4.0m. Minimum height of the general fluorescent lighting is 4.0m with intensity 500 lux over the playing surface. Flooring: Gerflor blue.

TABLE TENNIS ENGLAND RANKING SYSTEM

All match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England ranking system. The entry fee includes a charge for the administration of this system.

Directions to Venue

From Exeter – When arriving at Plymouth take the B3413 towards Leigham/Estover.

At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Delamere Road.

At the 3rd mini roundabout take the 2nd exit (turn right) onto Eggbuckland Road.

At the first mini roundabout take the first exit and stay on Eggbuckland Road.

Take a left turn onto Frogmore Avenue (this road then becomes Culver Way).

At the roundabout take 2nd exit onto Westcott Close and continue straight ahead onto the school grounds (through double red gates). Head towards the Sports Hall.

From Cornwall – When arriving in Plymouth from the Tamar Bridge follow the A38 taking the first exit towards St Budeaux/Ernesettle.

At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Crrownhill Road/B3413.

Continue on Crownhill Road for approximately 2.3 miles before turning right onto Widey Lane.

Stay on Widey Lane through 2 mini roundabouts.

At the 3rd roundabout take the first exit onto Westcott Close and continue straight ahead onto the school grounds (through double red gates). Head towards the Sports Hall.
