Esther Bourassa ran her helicopter through a tree after disorientation and failed attempt to use an automatic recovery feature of the helicopter. Dave Engel shared multiple crashes of the same large trainer he restored. The last of these crashes was attributed to pilot error. Peter Fales shared the crash of his quad copter. Had it in acro mode and lost control as it was heading towards the public behind the pilot line. Trying to keep it away from people, it ended up crashing into Bill Hickey's plane box, which was far less impactful than it could have been. The crowd seemed to like Peter's experience the best, awarding Peter the SAD patch for the evening.
