- 4. Do a pre-flight inspection of your aircraft or other flying machine. Check to make sure they all are airworthy. Safety First!
- 5. Cycle and check your batteries.
- 6. Check your transmitter, and do a range check if appropriate.
- 7. Check your fuel, tubing, fuel pump and starter motor.
- 8. Do a quick review of the Park District rules and regulations, and of the club safety guidelines.
- 9. Inventory your spare parts, such as glow plugs, props, wing fasteners and that the connectors are clean and in good working order.

#### Meeting Minutes – February 27, 2024


