In 2014, Leslie Harris decided to make her avocation into her vocation. She started a gardening business that concentrated on the maintenance and installation of containers and garden beds with a wonderful crew of horticulturists. Seven years later, she spun off her crew and began to concentrate on consulting, speaking, and her gardening podcast, *Into the Garden with Leslie*. In 2024 Leslie asked Marianne to join her and they created *The Garden Mixer* together.
