MCMGA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

11/13/2025

Attendees: Pam Horner, Darlene Davies-Warner, Jean Persely, Pam Voss, and Lisa Lane. Jean called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Approval of Last Meeting Minutes – Motion to approve by Darlene, and seconded by Lisa, motion carried.

MSUE updates – David was absent, but sent an email with the following updates: A new EMG coordinator was hired and will be in training for the next two months. The spring recognition event is tentatively scheduled for May 6, 2026 – speaker: Carolyn Miller of the MSU Arboretum will discuss her work with invasive species. The event will include a free dessert reception.

Treasurer's Report: October treasurer report was reviewed by the board. A motion was made to write off the \$10 missing payment from the plant sale, seconded, and the motion passed. A motion was made to approve the October treasurer report, was seconded, and the motion carried.

Education Chair Report: Ed programs are booked thru May and working to confirm remainder of year. Discussion held about rotating days of week (Tues, Weds, Thurs) to make programs available for more people with fixed schedules.

Grant Chair Report: 2025 Grant review – all reporting has been finalized and receipts turned in. Discussion held regarding grant amount and quantity. Tabled for further discussion at December meeting. Jean suggested grant application include payee name and mailing address and consider an electronic report vice poster board. Discussion held, all in agreement. Pam V will update documents to reflect changes.

Old Business: Electronic payment (Darlene) – Darlene provided a summary of various options for credit card payments including Zelle, Square, Clover GO, and Venmo along with the associated fees. Darlene recommended going with Square– it is free, cost is \$10 for one credit card reader, plus processing fees (2.6%, and \$0.15 per transaction). Everyone agreed, Darlene will set it up through MCMGA. The credit card processing fee will be paid by the member for each transaction.

General Discussion – There was a general discussion on the following: 1. Updating the website to include: past board members, listing of podcasts, past Lisianthus awardees; 2. Updating membership form to include speaker/topic suggestions and interest to host a garden walk; 3. Meeting schedule rotation; 4. Potential to schedule winter meetings on-line starting in 2027; 5. Pursue price estimate for two website candidates; 6. Update mission statement on website and SOP; 7. Update roles and responsibilities per meeting discussions.
