**Treasurer's Report**: September treasurer report was reviewed by the board. The final sales from the Native plant sale have not been resolved. There was a suggestion to look into electronic payment for next year's sale, and maybe use for membership as well. Lisa made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, Ellen seconded, all in favor, motion carried.

**Programs Update**: Cheryl English is scheduled to present in November about Tall Grasses. Ron Horner – tool workshop in January;.
