

**Bolivar County Council on Aging, Inc. (BCCOA)** is a public non-profit agency that was established as a rural transportation provider in 1975. Its' mission is to provide safe, efficient, reliable passenger focused and cost effective transportation which enhances lives to allow people to live independently and with dignity in the Mississippi Delta including Bolivar, Humphreys, Issaquena, Sharkey, Sunflower, Washington, and Yazoo, Madison, Warren and portion of Hinds counties. BCCOA traditionally provides flexible, demand response and commuter transportation services to employment, educational, medical, recreational, and social destinations. Services are available to the general public as well as to specialized groups such as the elderly and/or disabled.

BCCOA is in dual coordination partnership with Delta Rides and TransCon Regional Transportation Coordination Groups which allows for coordinated transportation within and outside of our designated service areas.

BCCOA has three service locations and is the home of the Delta Rides Regional Call Center.
