



General Park Rules

- For safety reasons glassware of any description is not permitted inside the park.
- Food, beverages or coolers may not be brought into the park. Baby food/ Infant food & drinks are permitted. Bags are subject to search by security staff.
- Suitable swimwear is highly recommended. Proper swim diapers are also highly recommended for babies and toddlers.

Children are also not allowed to do the ff:

- Do not drink the splash pad water
- NO running, horseplay or reckless behavior.
- Do not climb, hang or swing on any of the splash pad equipment.
- No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles or scooters.
- Pool toys, boats and other athletic equipment are not allowed in the splash pad area.
- No animals allowed in the splash pad area, except for service animals
- The splash pad is for recreation purposes, not for bathing. NO Soap, detergents or shampoos allowed.
- To ensure our guests safety, in the event of severe weather/storms management reserves the right to close attractions.
- All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult – children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Our attendants are trained to the highest level. Please adhere to their instructions failure to do so may result in expulsion without refund.
- Whilst all care is taken, guests enter the park at their own risk. The owners and/or management are not responsible for lost/stolen property or injury.
- The splash park is generally a non-smoking facility, parents/guardians are requested to smoke outside the premises.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry.
- Price/dates and timings are subject to change.
- Photograph/video taken for personal use only. Any use, re-use or reproduction for publication or commercial purposes requires a prior written consent from the management.
