



Cerebral Venous Sinus Thrombosis

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
Cerebral venous sinus thrombosis

- **Anticoagulation** — is the Rx of choice and successful in most cases.
- Catheter directed heparin infusion or pharmacomechanical thrombolysis if anticoagulation fails.

INDICATIONS:

- Presentation in coma.
- Clinical deterioration despite full anticoagulation.

Response after 48 hours of catheter directed thrombolysis



Recanalization of transverse and sigmoid sinus post thrombolysis and mechanical thrombectomy
