

Notes from the Playwright

Warning: This play does not take itself too seriously- please sit back, relax and enjoy the show! Also, the play is INTERACTIVE. Do not be surprised if the actors come off the stage and engage with you. Have fun with them!

The Commedia Tradition and Synopsis of the Play:

"All You Need is Love-a (Love-a. Love-a)!!! was inspired by Beaumarchais' "The Marriage of Figaro" written in 1778. It is a descendant of a theatre tradition called "Commedia dell'Arte" that began in Italy in the 1500s. Commedia is the origin of what we know today as "slapstick comedy" and was usually unscripted, relying on the actors' knowledge of their characters. The distinct personalities of the stock characters and the crazy elaborate jokes ("lazzi") help drive the plot. The storyline involves the class struggle between the rich and the poor.

There are three distinct social levels in this story- the "vecchi" (the old people): in this case, Dottora and Pantalona. Dottora is a big talker and likes to brag about her intelligence which is mainly pieces of paper; meaningless diplomas from unknown universities. Pantalona is extremely rich and cares only about her money and reputation at the cost of her daughter's happiness. The second level is the "Innamorati" -the lovers- Isabella (Pantalona's daughter) and Flavio (who turns out to be Dottora's servant, Puttanesca). They are deeply in love, but their affection is not approved by the Vecchi (Pantalona and Dottora) so the lovers suffer as a result. The third class is the "Zanni" or the "clowns" who try to outsmart the Vecchi so the lovers can be together. These are Puttanesca (Dottora's servant aka Flavio) as well as Arlecchina and Columbina who are Pantalona's servants.

Problems begin when Dottora arranges to have her "son", the arrogant braggart Capitano, become engaged to Isabella. Capitano does not love Isabella, he only wants her money. Isabella loves Flavio and wants nothing to do with Capitano, but she cannot disobey her mother.

The servants all decide to help unite the lovers. Will they succeed? Many merry mix ups occur and in the end there are three couples. Who will they be? Hopefully there will be a happy ending! They say love conquers all - or - All Junt Need in Lune-A, Lune-a, Lune-a, Lune-a.


