Our church has received an invitation to this event to be held at the Burge Memorial Church Cemetery on the corner of S. Hawthorne St. and Catawba Ave.

Ransom Hunter, born into slavery, is believed to be the first freed slave to own property in Gaston County. He owned land that today is downtown Mount Holly. In 2017 the Mount Holly Historical Society named him Person of the Year.
