### Hello!

I was showing a friend around the church recently. When we got to the Historical Room and she looked at the "Wall of Pastors," she asked me: "Are you so proud to be the first woman in that long line of male pastors?" The answer was "yes!" I clearly remember, when interviewing for this position, being asked by the Committee on Ministry representative to the Pastor Nominating Committee how I felt about potentially becoming the first female pastor of this church. I was excited! I can also look back to the day many years ago, when a woman pastor was hired by the church where I grew up—it was then that I learned that such a thing was possible, and the course of my life changed.

The *Presbyterian Outlook* magazine published an article last week by Frances Taylor Gench, professor of Biblical Interpretation at Union Seminary in Richmond. It is in response to those who, even today, would say that women should not serve as pastors. We've all heard the argument that the Bible says women should keep silent. To this narrow view, Gench addresses how Presbyterians approach scripture and why we have affirmed women in ministry since 1956. I have provided the article for you with this newsletter as I think you will learn a lot, not only about what the Bible says about women, but also about what it means to engage with scripture, and to wrestle with it, which Gench says in itself is an "act of faithfulness." Amen to that!

As this newsletter goes to print our Montreat participants are back from an amazing Youth Conference. We will enjoy a report and slide show from them in worship this Sunday, July 30! It was so good that they can't wait to go back next year!
