And here we are at the end of October already! The beautiful fall colors are wrapping us in the beauty of this season! We have many things to celebrate in the seasons of our worship services as well.

October 30 is "Reformation Sunday," a day on which we remember the roots of our tradition. The service will begin with the great hymn by Martin Luther: *A Mighty Fortress Is Our God,* written in 1529, and based on Psalm 46.

Our Presbyterian *Book of Order* notes that "Since the earliest days of the Reformation, Reformed Christians have marked the presence of the true church wherever:

the Word of God is truly preached and heard, the Sacraments are rightly administered, and ecclesiastical discipline is uprightly ministered.

As a church that is "reformed and always reforming" our *Book of Order* also says: "In Jesus Christ, who is the Lord of all creation, the church seeks a new openness to the sovereign activity of God in the Church and in the world, to a more radical obedience to Christ, and to a more joyous celebration in worship and work." Amen to that!

We will be engaging in "joyous celebration in worship" in upcoming Sundays as we observe baptism and remember the saints in our lives on Nov. 6, and as we receive confirmation students into membership on Nov. 13, and shortly after that we will enter into the season of Advent which is the new year of our liturgical calendar.

How wonderful it is to share the seasons of life and worship as the community of Christ in this place!
