Received the Kalinowski Family, Lisa, Joshua, and son Jacob, as members of our church family.

Approved a request from the Mt. Holly Athletic Association to use our parking lot for a yard sale, pending their providing a waiver that absolves the church from any liability connected to the yard sale.

Received a report from the Christian Education Committee about having intergenerational Vacation Bible School on June 12-14.

Approved a motion from the Mission and Outreach Committee that we send the \$500 gift given in memory of Rev. Rhoton, designated for charity, to the Presbyterian Board of Pensions Retired Ministers' Assistance Fund.

Approved a motion from the Mission and Outreach Committee to use \$100 of the committee's budgeted funds to contribute to the Presbyterian campaign for RIPmedicaldebt.org. This \$100 contribution will cover \$10,000 of individual hospital debt.

Approved a motion from the Buildings and Grounds Committee that we hire a company to repair and upgrade the sprinkler system in the Memorial Garden. The cost could be up to \$2000 and will come from the Building Fund account.
