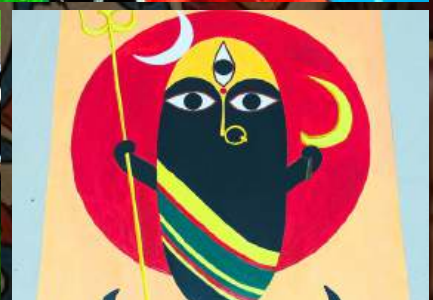

Is the visual arts ecosystem of SMAARTR, created to honour, elevate, and sustain creators who express powerful narratives through form, colour, texture, and lens.

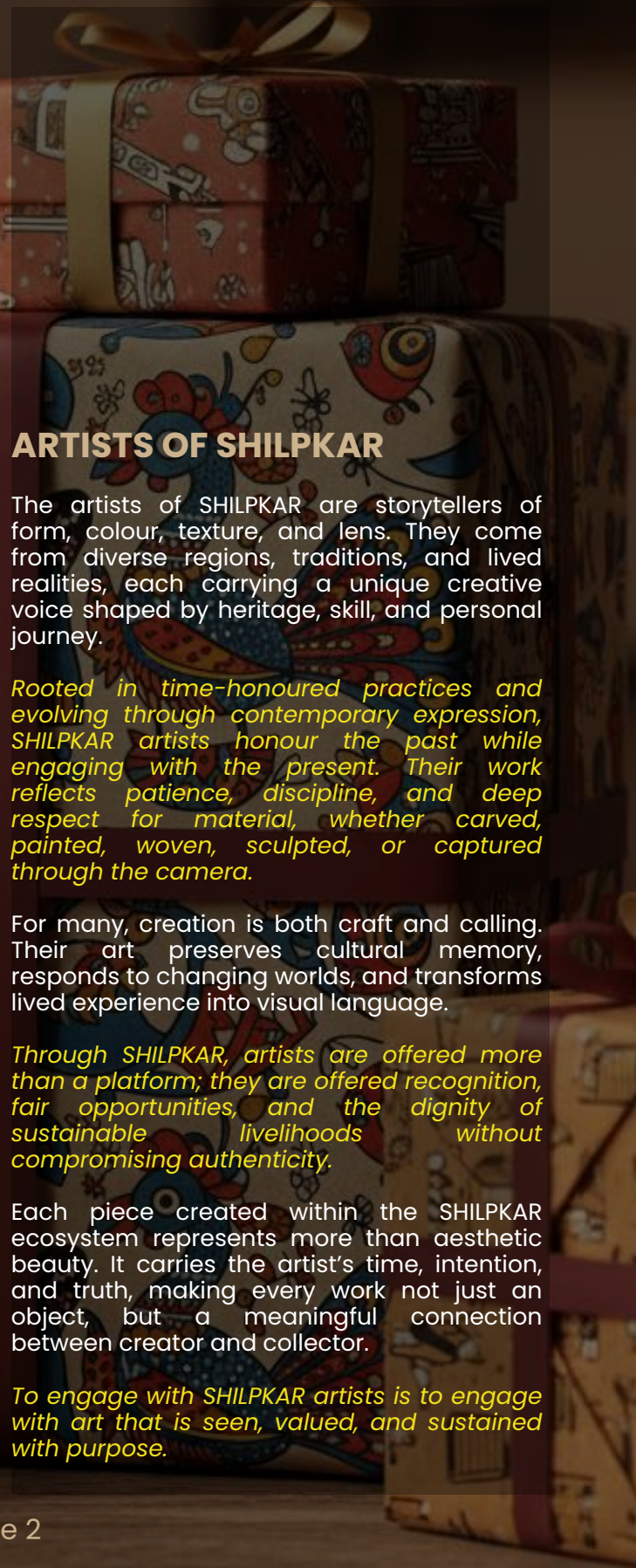
It brings together artisans, sculptors, craftists, painters, and photographers across geographies and generations, bridging traditional heritage with contemporary expression.

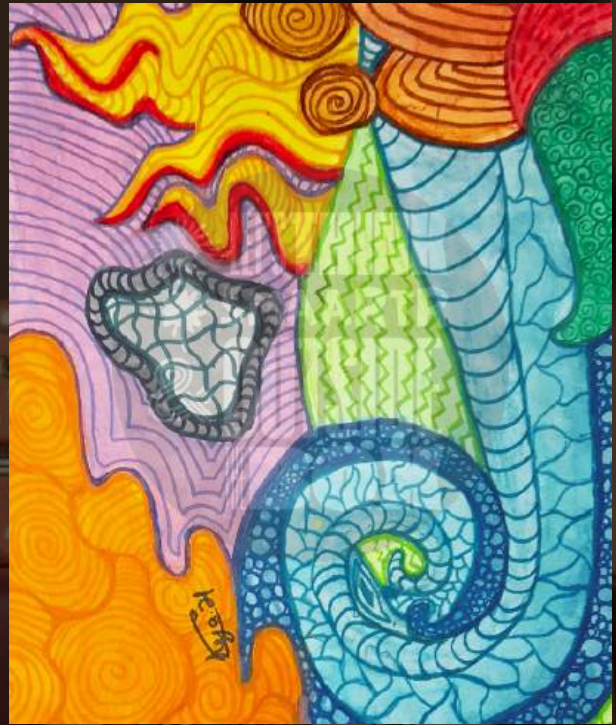

She is the founder of I M Possible & SMAART (IMPS) and SMAARTR, initiatives that create visibility, dignity, and sustainable livelihood opportunities for rare disease warriors and artists across India.

Keya's work reflects a powerful belief: art is not about limitation, it is about possibility.



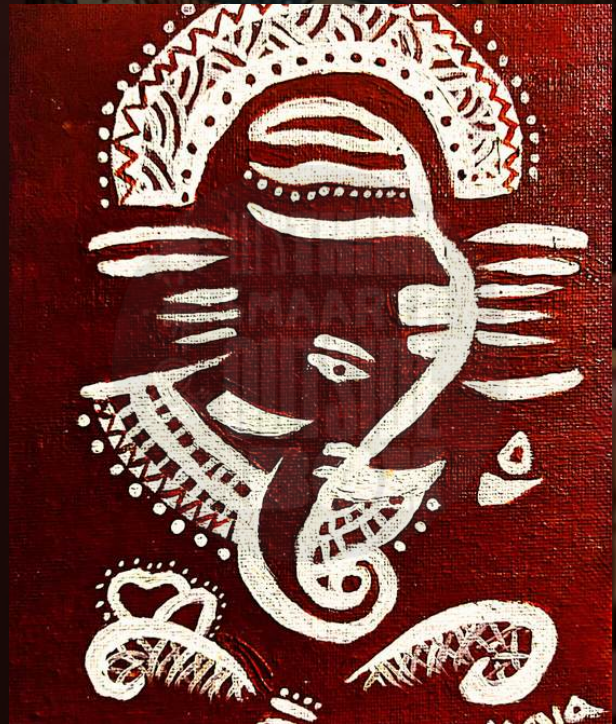

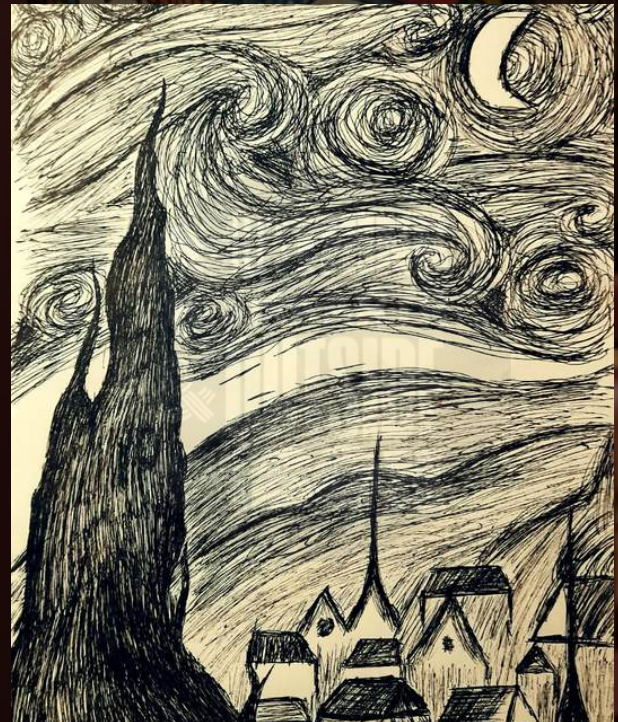

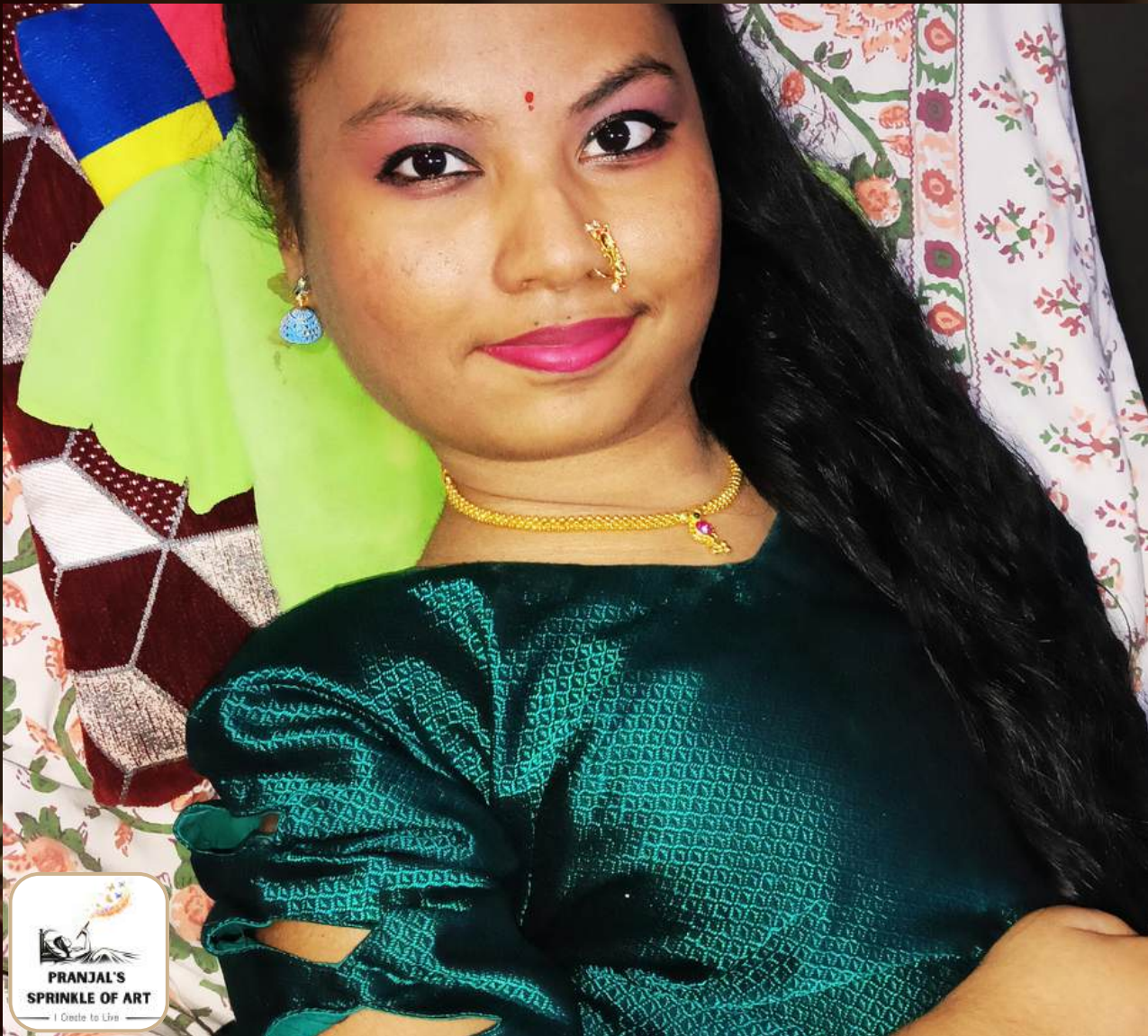

Pranjali hopes that this support and recognition for both her and the entire SMA community continues to grow to create a brighter and inclusive future for them.



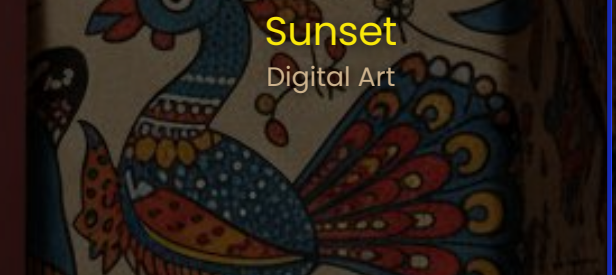
