# **Treasurer Report**

#### **Greens and Grounds**

The ongoing blinds maintenance is working well thanks to Ted Charman, John Corner and Peter Honson.

Sportcrete are planning to return prior to Christmas look at issues of concern with the surface. Recommend that the surface be used as much as possible

Mount Barker Steel have agreed to manufacture the additional scoreboards.

The greens maintenance members have asked for a new steel template to be used for marking the lines on the greens.

There will be a change of playing direction on the green under the Dome after the Fours Club Championships being played on Saturday 21 Dec. Set play will play the opposite direction on Monday 16 Dec.

Selection – There has been an unusually high number of players unavailable for games during the first part of the season with impacts on positions in all sides.

The Club is having some issues filling the third Wednesday side most weeks, needs consideration going forward.

The Club also needs to consider issues around the Thursday competition.

#### Bar

The bar continues to trade profitably.

While an extension to the bar area could be considered, retention of the eight ball table with an increased use of the table also needs to be taken into consideration.
