- **Expression of Interest (EOI)**

Interested candidates must fill the Google Form to show interest and attach their CV. This step helps assess basic eligibility and alignment with the fellowship objectives.

- **Panel Screening & Shortlisting (CV Review)**

A Selection Panel will review submitted CVs and shortlist candidates based on academic background, professional experience, research orientation, and interest in HEOR domains.

- **Interview Round**

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for a personal interview to evaluate motivation, clarity of career goals, communication skills, and readiness for the fellowship.

- **Final Selection & Admission Confirmation**

Successful candidates will receive selection and admission confirmation along with program details and timelines.

- **Fee Payment & Seat Confirmation**

Admission will be finalized upon fee payment within the stipulated time, after which the seat will be officially confirmed.
